

# Indigenous Advisory and Monitoring Committee for the Trans Mountain Expansion and Existing Pipeline

#### **About the Committee:**

The Indigenous Advisory and Monitoring Committee for the Trans Mountain Expansion and Existing Pipeline (IAMC-TMX) brings together 13 Indigenous and six senior federal representatives to provide advice to regulators and to monitor the TMX and existing pipeline. Members have a shared goal of safety and protection of environmental and Indigenous interests in lands and waters. Participation by an Indigenous community does not mean that it supports or opposes the project. The Committee is a forum for engagement with Government and Regulators. However, as it enters the final year of its mandate, the Committee will be looking to evolve from being an advisory body to one with an oversight function.

#### **Priorities:**

The IAMC-TMX brings together Indigenous communities, government departments, federal regulators, Trans Mountain Corporation and other parties to:

- Build shared understanding of Indigenous issues and interests as it concerns TMX;
- Enhance relationships between the parties; and
- Foster dialogue/formulate advice as to how to improve policy and monitoring including with respect to worker accommodation.





The Committee's three priority areas are:

- 1. Indigenous Monitoring;
- 2. Emergency Management; and
- 3. Work Camps and the Influx of Temporary Workers

The Committee is also actively looking at the marine safety system, given the marine shipping aspect of the project.

To provide input and advice to the Committee on specific issues, the IAMC-TMX created the following subcommittees and groups:

- 1. Indigenous Monitoring
- 2. Marine Shipping
- 3. Socioeconomic
- 4. Operations
- 5. Emergency Management Working Group
- 6. COVID-19 Task Force
- 7. Indigenous Monitoring Policy Table

Each subcommittee and working group undertakes work that requires more expertise or focus on a particular issue. Each group develops work plans, budgets and activities that are approved by the Committee.
